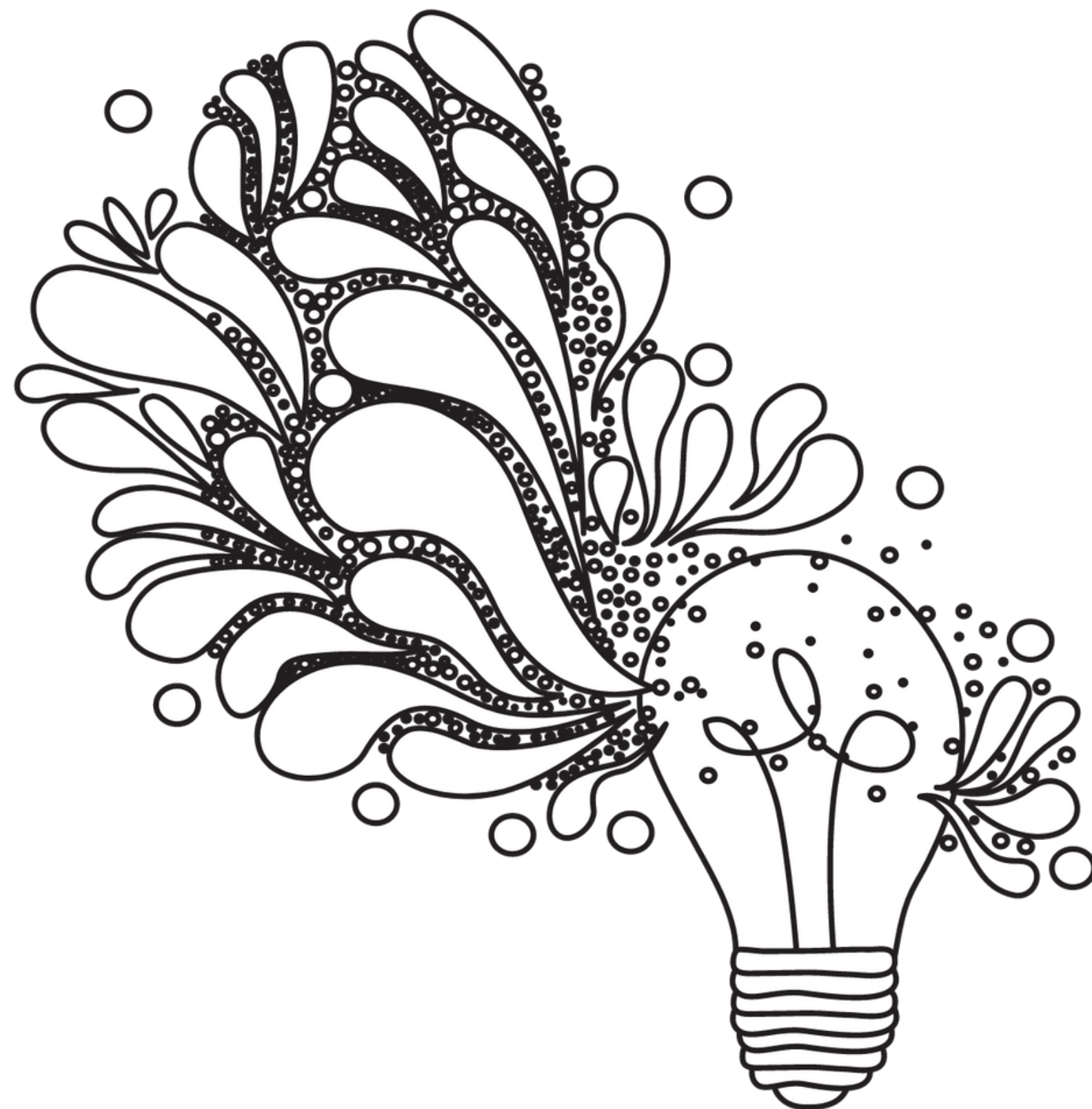


YMCA AMBASSADOR TRAINING

Target group

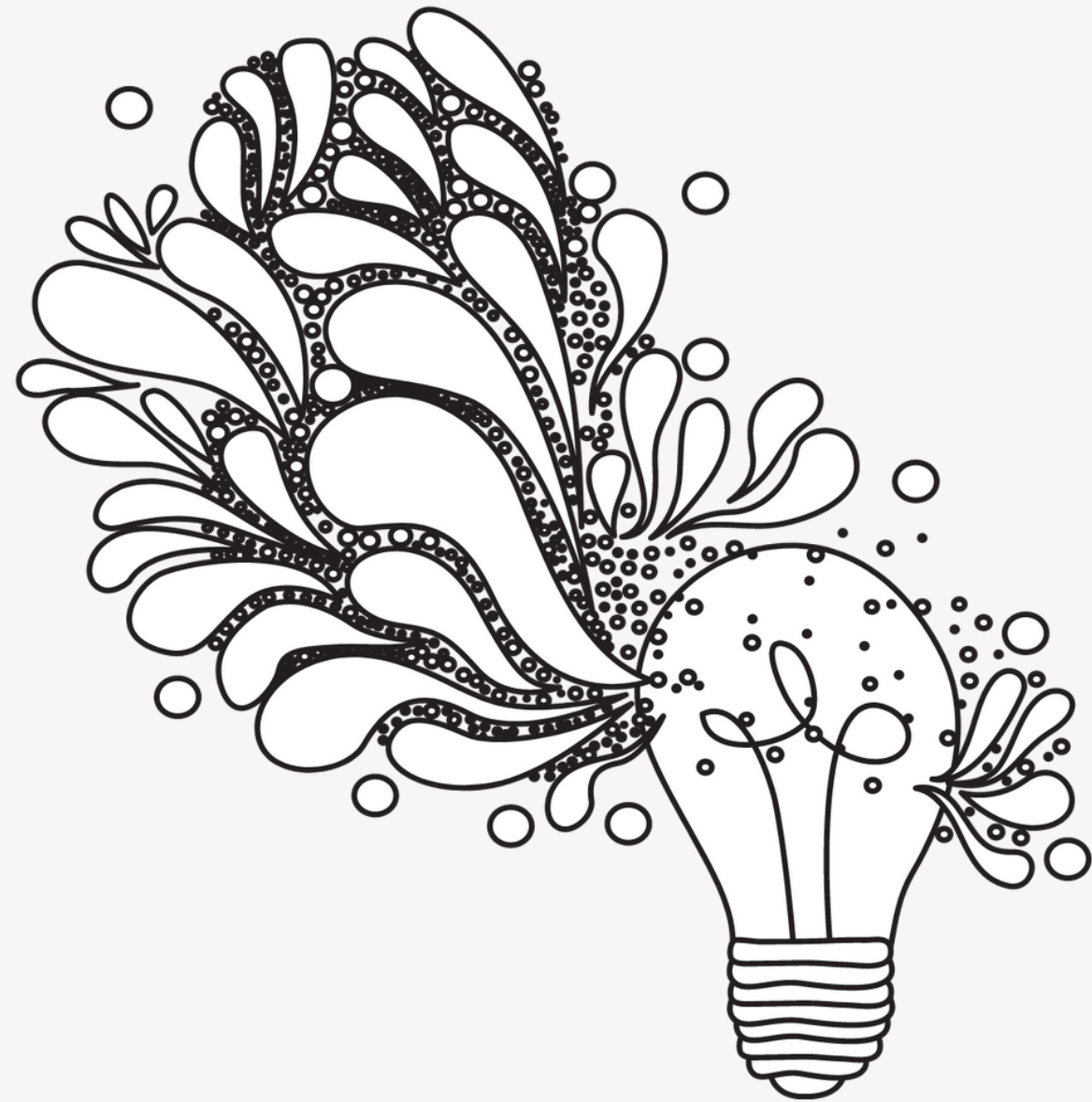
Young adults aged 18-26 who are involved in the respective YMCA, speak good English and are motivated to take part in this project.

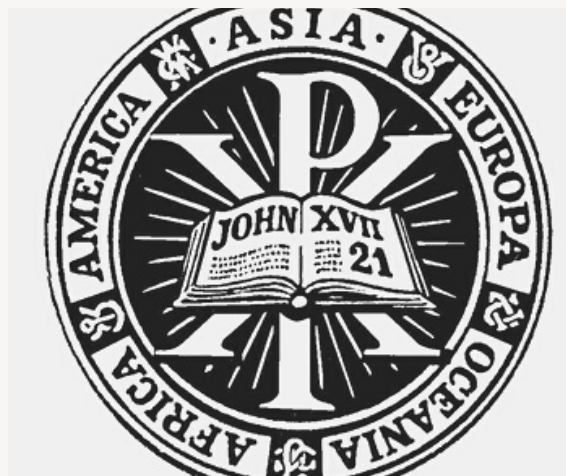
